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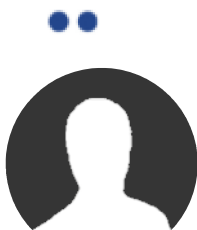

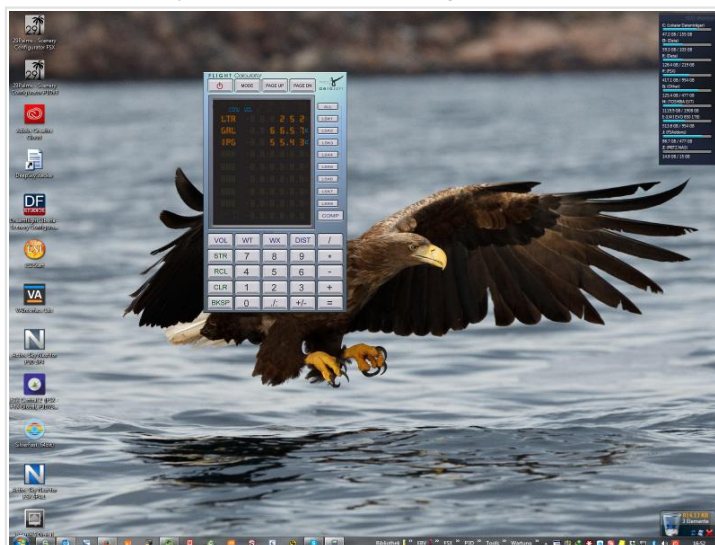

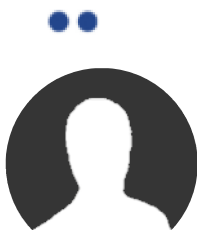

Since this obsolete ex-payware program is not going to be refreshed, why not simply change the description by removing the comment that it IS

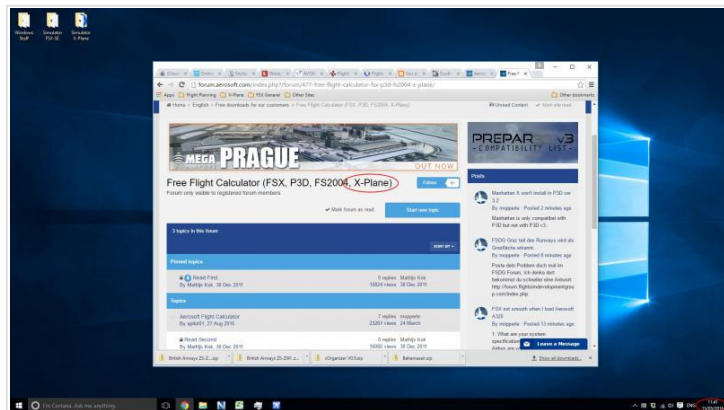
compatible with X-Plane (see attached JPG)?

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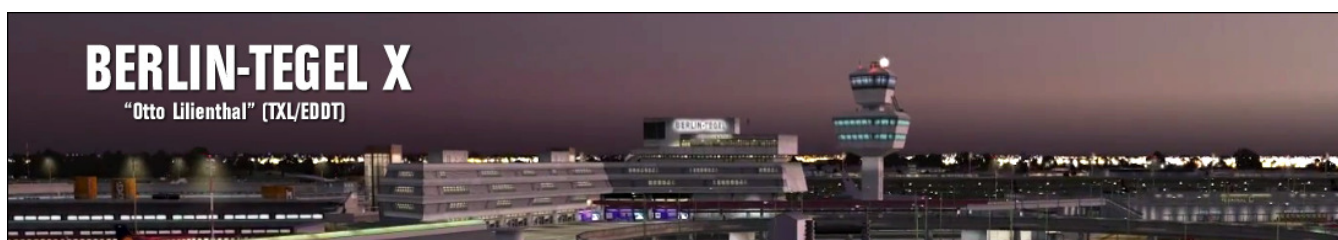


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
